



UNIFORM POLICY

K-12 Uniform Policy

The uniform policy for K-12 students is designed to promote equality, discipline, and a sense of belonging while adhering to cultural values and school regulations.

General Guidelines

1. Mandatory Uniform Wear:

All students are required to wear the designated school uniform daily, including during school events unless otherwise instructed.

2. Neatness and Cleanliness:

Students must ensure their uniforms are clean, well-maintained, and properly always worn.

3. Compliance with Cultural Values:

The uniform must align with cultural and religious expectations, ensuring it is modest and respectful.

Uniform Requirements by Grade Level

Kindergarten (K):

- **Boys and Girls:**

- Comfortable, modest tops with school logo.
- Stretchable trousers or shorts (appropriate length).
- Black closed toe shoes.

Primary (Grades 1-5):

- **Boys:**

- Blue button-down shirt with school logo.
- Navy blue pants, skirts, or dresses (below knee-length).
- Black closed toe shoes.

- **Girls:**

- Blue button-down shirt with school logo.
- Navy blue pants, skirts, or dresses (below knee-length).
- Black closed toe shoes.
- Hair neatly tied back.

Middle (Grades 6–8):

- **Boys:**

- Light blue polo shirts with school logo.
- Navy blue pants (no jeans).
- Optional navy-blue school sweater during cooler months.
- Black closed toe shoes.

- **Girls:**

- Light blue polo shirts with school logo
- Navy blue skirts (below knee-length) or pants.
- Optional navy-blue school sweater during cooler months.
- Black closed toe shoes.
- Minimal accessories.
- Hair neatly tied back.
- No makeup

High School (Grades 9–11):

- **Boys:**

- White polo shirts with the school logo.
- Navy blue/Black pants (no jeans or cargo pants).
- Optional navy-blue school sweater during cooler months.
- Black closed toe shoes.

- **Girls:**

- White polo shirts with school logo.

- Navy blue/Black skirts (below the knee) or pants.
- Black closed toe shoes.
- Hair neatly tied back.
- No makeup
- Minimal accessories.

High School (Grades 12):

- Students design uniforms annually
- Black closed toe shoes.
- Hair neatly tied back.
- No makeup
- Minimal accessories.

PE and Sports Uniforms

- All students are required to wear the designated PE uniform, consisting of:
 - A T-shirt or sports top with the school logo.
 - Tracksuit bottoms or shorts (appropriate length).
 - Sports shoes with non-marking soles.

Prohibited Items

- Bright or flashy shoes
- Excessive jewelry
- Inappropriate hairstyles.
- Make-up

Enforcement and Penalties

1. Parental Notification:

Parents will be informed if a student fails to comply with the uniform policy.

2. Disciplinary Measures:

Repeated non-compliance may result in a warning, detention, or other actions as deemed appropriate by the administration.
